## **MESSAGE FROM PASTOR**

Perhaps you've heard the comical (though not real) story about the man who was on a diet and drove by a bakery each day on his way to work. One day, knowing he was coming up on the bakery, he prayed "Lord, if it's your will for me to get a cake from the bakery, let there be an open parking place right in front of it." When he arrived at work with a cake in hand, his co-worker said to him "I thought you were on a diet ..." The man went on to recount how he had prayed about God's will for him to have the cake, explaining "wouldn't you know it, the eleventh time I circled around the bakery, there was a parking space right in front!" While this story is light-hearted and funny, it is representative of a serious matter that many Christians have questions about. Namely, how can we know the Lord's will in something? While the space in this newsletter wouldn't come close to allowing for a comprehensive consideration of this topic, I'd

like to highlight three overarching applications that will enable us to best perceive and receive the will of the Lord:

- Pray for His Will to be Done When Jesus was teaching His disciples to pray, He said "Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name; Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" [Matt. 6:9-10]. Follow Jesus's example, pray for God's will to be done on earth as it is in heaven, including in your life and situation.
- Prepare your Heart and Mind to Know His Will When Paul wrote to Roman Christians, by the leadership of the Holy Spirit, he said "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect" [Rom. 12:2]. Note two things here: first we can discern the will of God, and second, we are prepared to discern it by having our minds transformed, which comes through the regular study and application of God's word.
- Practice Determine to put the Lord's will into practice in your life as He Reveals it.
   The Psalmist of Psalm 119 prayed "Your testimonies are my delight; they are my counselors" [Psalm 119:24]. May it be so of our lives too. Ask the Lord to help you take delight in knowing and doing His will.

We observed Airing of the Quilts on Sunday, August 20th, with quilts decorating the sanctuary and vestibule. The Sew'n Sews, a less visible ministry, began in 1990 at the home of Dorothy Childers making lap blankets for children in hospitals. Mildred Asby is the only original member. In 2018, they began giving the guilts to Pre-schoolers and Kindergarteners in all of Macon County schools. This year they made 570 quilts, more than doubling the number made in 2018.
