MESSAGE FROM PASTOR

The restoration company SERVPRO has a slogan which speaks to the thoroughness of the job they seek to do, "Like it never even happened." Fortunately, I've never needed their services so I can't speak first about their capability to fulfill such a tall order. What I can speak to from first-hand knowledge is the fact that, when I make a mess of things in my own life or relationships, I wish it was like it never even happened. However, as is the case with damage to our homes, damage in these areas reguires a process of restoration. And no matter how good they may be at cleaning up water damage, SERVPRO can't help us when sin is at the root of the problem.

So where do we turn for that kind of restoration? The answer is to the Living Word of God, Jesus, and the written word of God, the Bible. Of course, there's no way to unpack every possible facet and factor of this truth in a brief newsletter article. Consider though that there are no less than ten words in the Greek language of the New Testament which have to do with God's work of restoration, with a range of meanings such as "to give back", "to set straight again", "to renew", "bring to completion", "to mediate", "to arrange in order", etc. Suffice it to say that our God is a God of restoration. In both the Old

and New Testaments, there are numerous ways in which the Lord covenants with His people to restore them or to restore something to them.

We should recognize that the end of all such restoration may not be "like it never even happened" on this side of eternity. That's the reality of living in a sin -cursed, fallen world. This is why we as Christians look not only to that which is seen but also to that eternity beyond compare and comprehension that awaits all who are in Christ. Nevertheless, we must remember that there is always the opportunity for the Christian to experience the process (2) Chronicles. 7:14) and the promise (1 John. 1:9) of restoration with our Lord. And. when we have sought the Lord in light of this truth, we can say like David, "He restores my soul" (Psalm 23:3).
